The reality of parents not knowing what their children are doing when they are at work, is not always a nice one. With YCRC, they have a group of volunteers who will teach them that they do not have to get into trouble when they are not around their parent(s) or guardians. I look forward to seeing this organization grow."

YCRC is a 501(c)(3) with the mission of providing youth with the necessary communication skills for handling conflict in both home and school life. The five-hour workshops are held on Saturdays, and can be divided into hour sessions to accommodate after-school program.

"As an organization, we believe strongly in partnering with people and organizations who understand the need for conflict resolution to be taught at a young age. The Power Hour will be a great medium for YCRC to reach parents and learn what concerns they feel their youth need help with," said Diana Clark, Founder of YCRC.
